- Longer portions of text from the Pippi Longstocking books do not count as free-standing quotes and must therefore be used with care in your material.
- All theatre plays based on Astrid Lindgren's stories require a contract of approval. The theatre publishers keep track of which plays are being performed where and when, to prevent them from coinciding with each other, as a theatre production can be running over a longer period – often several months. This does not apply to the three plays included in the toolkit Congrats Pippi!
- Pippi only exists in her own world – the one created by Astrid Lindgren. That means, amongst other things, that a grown person dressed up to look like Pippi should not host a conference, read stories to the children, hand out bags of sweets or do similar things.
- Please read out loud to the children but remember that Pippi is not able to read, so naturally she must not be the one reading to the children.
- You are free to use the illustrations on a smaller scale and in their physical form, e.g. to decorate the premises, make an event poster, flyer or similar. Your own event poster or web advertisement/banner that includes an illustration may be used digitally, but for all other digital use we ask you to contact The Astrid Lindgren Company for approval. The material must not be used commercially.
