Welcome to SHE 2022

The Swedish Institute SHE 2022 Leadership Programme is a leadership development programme for women executives based in Saudi Arabia and the United Arab Emirates. Hosting 20-30 participants per year since 2017 it is also a growing network of professional women in the Gulf region.

For participants, SHE is an exclusive opportunity to harvest the latest theoretical and practical insights into innovative leadership. Through networking opportunities, workshops, panel discussions and interactive materials participants are offered the opportunity to reflect and mature in their leadership skills.

For Sweden, the program is a way to build relationships with key players in the Gulf markets: both companies and individuals.

The 2022 programme will focus on advancing our participants as leaders in a VUCA world, managing in a fast paced work environment and changing societies. It will consist of **two live networking opportunities** and **four different interactive workshops**. For each workshop, participants are expected to prepare by taking part of an **online information material**.

Applications will be reviewed by the Swedish Institute and **shortlisted candidates will be contacted for a video-link application interview**. After the interviews a final selection of participants will be made.

- Proficient in English
- Between 25-45 years of age
- In an executive, managerial or expert position
